Professional Development Policy

Lochside Elementary School 2024/25

- This policy will be reviewed annually at the October staff meeting before being submitted to the Joint Professional Development Committee.
- 2. Professional Development money will be held in a Group Account.
- 3. Each full-time and part-time teacher's Professional Development allowance is approximately \$450 per year or \$900 over two years. If you work part time at Lochside and also TTOC or work at an alternate school, you are advised to access only one Prod account.
- 4. To access money from the group account, teachers will apply to the STA Professional Development Representative at the school before the event/purchase takes place. Requests that exceed \$450 per person per year will be reviewed initially by the Pro-D rep, who will consider how much Pro-D funding was provided to that staff member in the previous year. Generally, large requests will not be approved for the same person in two consecutive years, unless within \$900.00 over two years. The maximum amount the Pro-D accounts person will approve for a single year is \$900.00. Teachers who are transferred to another school in the district cannot access funds from this account once they have left. If a person was not on staff at Lochside in the previous year, the limit for the year will be \$450.
- 5. Teachers who exceed the amount of money allocated to them or who fail to seek pre-approval may bear the additional costs themselves.
- 6. All requests for funding must be accompanied by original receipts.
- 7. The STA Professional Development Representative manages the teacher professional development account and is responsible for decisions related to teacher professional development money. This person may have a committee or clerical assistance but is ultimately the manager of this money.
- 8. Teachers may use Professional Development funds for any professional development activity that falls within the guidelines set by the Joint Professional Development Committee.
 - a. Professional Conference registration and related expenses
 - b. Professional workshops in and out of district

- c. School visits
- d. Non-credit courses
- e. Credit courses (special form required)
- f. Professional association membership dues
- g. Expenses and honoraria for presenters
- h. Individual research expenses EXCLUDING personal payment
- i. Professional books and journals
- j. Staff retreats/staff development activities.
- Release time for staff-initiated meetings and work sessions. Cost of TTOC has increased to \$512/Day.

NOTE: Professional Development funds may not be used to purchase equipment of any kind or for personal payment of any kind.
